6) Any Other Business

- a) Buddy transport scheme working well. System publicised by word of mouth grown gradually and cautiously to ensure it could cope with demand. Aim to accompany vulnerable to appts. to ensure attendance. Care Shop to pilot NHS app.
- b) Karen Halford at practice/Care Shop working well.
- c) Patient Group and Friends of SMP separate in Selsey all other practices are combined. Friends are purely fund raising & Patient Group assist SMP where possible. Envisaged Patient Group will be more outward looking.
- d) Stroke services SRH to become Acute Stroke Centre = 24/7 qualified specialist in all necessary fields to enable positive patient outcomes (Worthing to no longer have stroke services). Comprehensive Stroke Centres at Brighton and Southampton = can do neurosurgery and thrombectomy operations there. As only 10 qualified surgeons in that field in country, unlikely SRH will become a comprehensive centre. Care Shop have consultation forms for local opinion on proposed upgrade. The upgrade in stroke services could impact on buddy transport scheme for outpatient appts.
